Ideas and Methodologies

- For this lesson, students will create personalized poetry notebooks.
- It may be helpful to begin with poems covered as a class. Children are encouraged to read poetry on their own during silent reading, library visits and at home.
- If a student finds a poem that is especially interesting to them, they mark it with a post-it and place the book in their teacher's faculty mailbox.
- Every week, these poems are to be copied and printed for the students to include in their notebooks.
